

Use a Gift From Your IRA to Improve Your Community and Reduce Your 2018 Taxes

When IRA owners reach the age of 70½, they are required to take a minimum distribution (RMD) from their account every year. A new provision allows account owners to direct transfers of up to \$100,000 each year to qualified charities without treating the distribution as taxable income.

Qualified IRA Charitable Rollover gifts to Arkansas Community Foundation can go to any charity of the donor's choice through a designated, community impact or field of interest fund based on their charitable goals.

To encourage IRA gifts, Arkansas Community Foundation is offering a special incentive. A dollar for dollar match will be provided for any gifts made to a foundation-directed unrestricted fund including Giving Tree endowments prior to June 2019.

Please note: Donor advised funds, supporting organizations, charitable gift annuities and charitable remainder trusts are not eligible recipients of IRA Charitable Rollover gifts. The fiscal year 2019 match pool is limited to \$50,000 and will be depleted on a first come/first serve basis.
